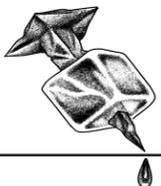
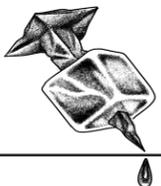

The Hologram is a lightweight, replicable, autonomous protocol for human cooperation which produces de-institutionalized stability. In this non-expert web of support, 3 people (the triangle) ask questions to a 4th one (the hologram) in a struc-

tured ritual. The hologram ensures that each triangle member also has support, growing the rhizome of care. We believe that hologrammers and their communities may be able to survive differently, and produce new ways of living that don't rely on or reproduce the toxic systems killing us.
